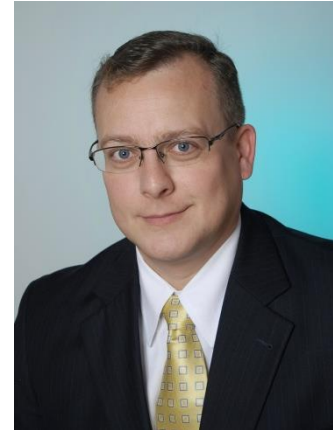


Speaker's Profile

Current:

- Christian König works as Head of Legal Affairs for the Association of Private Bausparkassen in Berlin and is responsible for all German and European legal affairs dealing and affecting the business of Bausparkassen and other credit institutes financing home ownership. His scope of work includes the evaluation of legislative proposals of the European and German institutions dealing with banking, contract and consumer protection law but also housing policy.
